

## Course Overview

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The English Morpho-Syntax learning material consists of 9 modules which explain the theory and application of English word formation systems. Learning material includes introduction to morpho-syntax, morphemes and words, word formation, morphological processes, phrase structure, sentence structure, and using tree diagrams in sentence analysis.

After studying this course, students are expected to be able to explain the basic concepts of formation and rules for forming English words, phrases, clauses, and sentences and apply them in analyzing English texts.

Each module is accompanied by exercises related to the topics discussed, accompanied by answer keys and tools to measure the achievement of learning objectives.

Students are expected to be able to understand the learning objectives in each module, read and understand the learning material, and do the exercises provided. After finishing reading the learning material and doing the exercises in the module, students can take the formative test without looking at the answer key. After completing the formative test, students are allowed to look at the answer key to find out to what extent students can understand the contents of the module given.

The author hopes that this learning material is useful for increasing students' understanding of the word and sentence formation system in English.
