Course Overview

The course that we will study is called Telematics Law. Telematics Law encompasses the subjects that will be examined in more detail in Modules 1 to 9. This Core MaterialBook consists of 9 Modules, consisting of.

Module 1: The Definition and Scope of Telematics Law

This module discusses the understanding of the convergence of communication information technology, the influence of internet development on information and communication technology, law and information technology, legal issues arising from advances in information technology, and international aspects of information technology.

Module 2: Jurisdiction and The Choice of Cyber Law

This module discusses the definition of jurisdiction and types of jurisdictions in cyber law, applications of jurisdictions in the United States and in the European Union, and choice of law in e-commerce disputes.

Module 3: Case Studies Related to Cyber Law

This module discusses examples of cases in cyber law, and the example cases in e-commerce.

Module 4: E-Commerce On Model Law 1996

This module discusses the nature and characteristics of e-commerce, the scope of e-commerce, the development of e-commerce in Indonesia and other countries, legal issues that arise, and jurisdiction in cyber law.

Module 5: Legal Aspects of Obligations and Proof on Electronic Evidence

This module discusses the general conception of obligations, e-contract, the binding requirements of an electronic contract, the valid requirement of an electronic contract, types of electronic contracts.

Module 6: Domain Name and Digital Signatures

This module discusses the case of Klik BCA's domain name, understanding the audiopoint domain name case, understanding the Nokia domain name case, understanding the Mustika Ratu domain name case.

Module 7: Legal Review of Electronic Fund Transfers

This module discusses the definition of an agreement, an overview of banking in Indonesia, the definition of funds transfer, and funds transfer through electronic media (Electronic Funds Transfer).

Modul 8 : Copyright Protection in Songs or Music Published or Propagated Through Internet Media

This module discusses the protection of copyrighted songs on the internet media, and effective efforts to protect songs or music that are published or augmented through the internet media.

Modul 9: Telematics Development and Its Relation to National Law Towards Law-Smart Society

This module discusses the role and impact of information and communication technology, and technological developments in the industrial revolution.
