

Course Overview

Teaching English as a Foreign Language 2 (TEFL 2) is designed to equip the students with the knowledge and skills in teaching English as a foreign language. To acquire the knowledge and skills the students have to learn thoroughly the theories depicted from many different perspectives presented by the writers. As well, the teaching methodology of different kinds is also provided to help the students (the learners) develop the four language skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing; and the components of language such as grammar and vocabulary. In addition, the students are acquainted to learn how the four skills of language are developed in integrated ways. Teaching English through literary works is also covered in this course to help the learners of elementary and secondary schools achieve the communicative competence in English, and appreciate the works of English literature.

The students are acquainted with the new English curriculum, the competency-based curriculum, specifically designed by the National Education Department to improve the English instruction in elementary and secondary school levels. The characteristics of the new curriculum, the communicative competence, are delineated as the basis for the selection of the teaching techniques, strategies, media, and the material development for the effective teaching.

The students are not only required to obtain the knowledge of the theories of various teaching methodology, but they are also required to be skilful in determining the techniques and strategies appropriate to be implemented in the classroom. In other words, the students are required to be able to put the theories into classroom practices.

The topics discussed in this course encompass communicative competence, teaching vocabulary, teaching grammar, teaching listening, teaching speaking, teaching reading, teaching writing, teaching integrated skills, and teaching English through literature. In order to acquire the knowledge, the students are required to read all materials in the modules. At the end of each semester, the students have to show their competence and ability in solving the summative test problems in the form of objective test.
